# Letter from Sarah



Dear Friends,

This past year has been one of bold transformation at Teton Youth & Family Services.

We are nearing the finish line of our \$18 million capital campaign – a once-in-a-generation effort to rebuild and reimagine the foundation of our programs. With the final building set to open this fall, our campuses are now safer, more welcoming, and better equipped to support the youth and families who need us most.

But the heart of our work goes beyond buildings. From launching our first-ever Youth Mental Health Summit (which brought together over 150 community members) to providing therapeutic care at Red Top Meadows for over 15 young men (even while operating at reduced capacity due to construction), we've continued to meet the evolving needs of our valley with compassion, creativity, and resolve.

Approximately 85% of our annual budget is dedicated directly to program services; a reflection of our deep commitment to delivering impactful, hands-on care. But this vital work is only possible because of your support.

As Old Bill's Fun Run approaches, I invite you to walk alongside us once again. Every gift to TYFS through Old Bill's is matched, doubling your impact, and helping us provide safety, healing, and hope to even more kids across Wyoming.

The finish line is near. Let's cross it together.


